Filia Milidaki has a background as psychologist, market researcher and contemporary dancer and is the founder of the Social Cooperative Enterprise "Cinesthesia". Since 2014 she is the curator and the visionary behind the international Eye's Walk Digital Festival. The festival is based in Syros island, in the middle of the Aegean sea. Eye's Walk digital festival connects to the unique architectural legacy of a city by creating a layer of digital work (projections, installations, performative) to interface the public space with the local community. Storytelling and narratives are key to the work as is the Greek word (Eros)).

"I perceive my curatorial work as an act of "Eros", that infuses the city with different emotional and physical states, transfiguring it, into a transformative –creative experience with a potentially tremendous impact on neighborhoods' life, street stories, closed windows' agony".
